Step 1: Fill out the ROTH ID TAG™

On the front of the tag, write your child's name or initials. This is so you know which child's information is on the tag, and so first responders know which child came out of which seat.

On the back of the tag, use a black permanent pen or fine point marker to legibly write in your child's name and information. If you are worried about your handwriting, ask someone to help you or use a label maker. The goal is for responders to be able to quickly identify your child.

Next fill in any known medical conditions important in an emergency, such as; allergies, non-verbal, autism, heart murmur. If the child is not riding with a parent, you can also write who the child is riding with. Lastly, you need to identify three (3) people to contact in an emergency by name, as well as their phone numbers.

We suggest you ask your contacts for their permission and write down your child's information and share it with them. Inform them that they are an emergency contact and ask them to keep their information in their purse or wallet.

Step 2: Apply the ROTH ID TAG™

Locate a highly visible area on the side or back of your child's car seat where you wish to secure the ROTH ID TAG™. Verify you would not be obscuring any important information related to the device you are using (safety information, product codes, etc.). Remove the two sided adhesive strips and apply the ROTH ID TAG™ to the side or back of your child's car seat or other piece of equipment. The ROTH ID TAG™ should be applied in temperatures above 50°F to a carseat that is between 50 and 80°F.

In order to make sure the ROTH ID TAG™ doesn't interfere with the safety of the carseat, the tag should never be placed on the front of the carseat. This also reduces the risk that the child passenger might remove the tag themselves.

Step 3: Apply the Signal Tag

In order to alert first responders that there is a ROTH ID TAG™ on the car seat that may not be immediately visible, we include a Signal Tag with every ROTH ID TAG™. Place the Signal Tag on the side of the carseat, near the top, in a highly visible area for first responders. This way they will know to look for the ROTH ID TAG™.

Additional Applications

ROTH ID TAG™S™ can be applied to almost any hard flat surface. While we started with a goal of having emergency identifying information on car seats, our tags can be applied to strollers, wheel chairs, walking devices, bicycles, helmets, UTV's, and more.

In Case of Emergency

When needed in an emergency, grip the tag from the end noted on the ROTH ID TAG™ and pull firmly until the bracelet portion detaches. Remove the small tab on the end to expose the adhesive for the bracelet. Carefully place the bracelet around the user's arm or leg, with the name and other information showing and use the adhesive side to secure the bracelet to the user's arm or leg.

Tag Removal

Be sure when you are done with your car seat that you remove the ROTH ID TAG™. Simply tear off in the direction of the arrows and dispose of the used tag.

Keeping Information Updated

Updating Information On the Tag

Due to the nature of the tag, information cannot be updated once the tag is applied to a carseat or piece of equipment. Visit ROTHIDTAG.com to order a low-cost replacement tag.

It is vital that you regularly check your child's emergency contacts and update your tag if there are any changes in your child's medical information, or your emergency contact's information.
